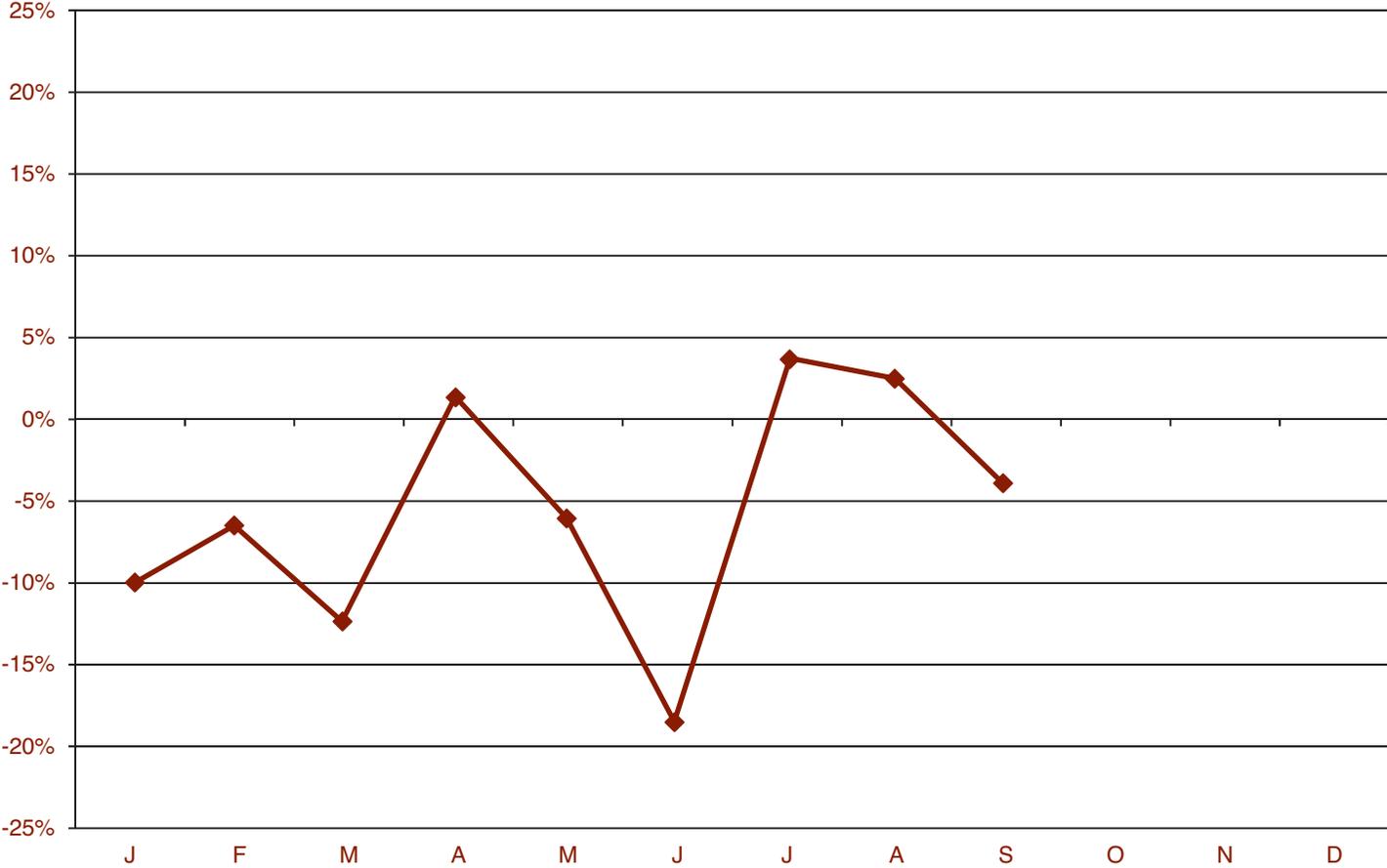

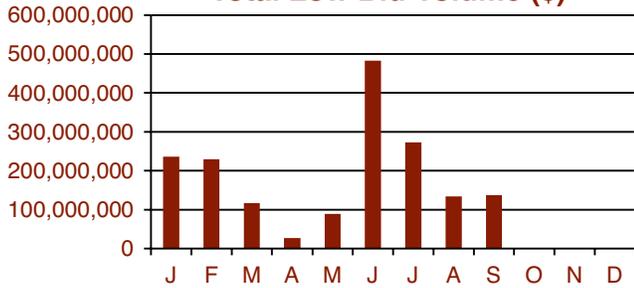

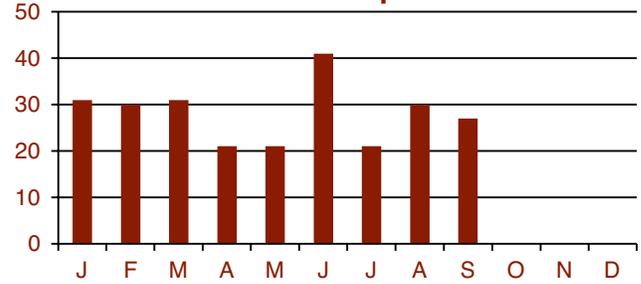

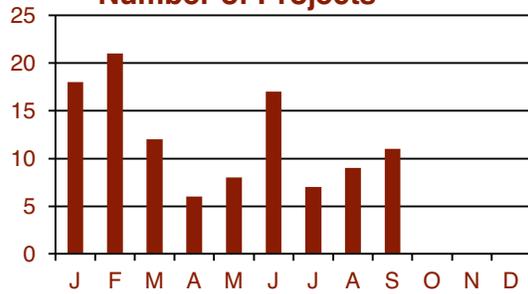
Total Low Bid Volume (\$)



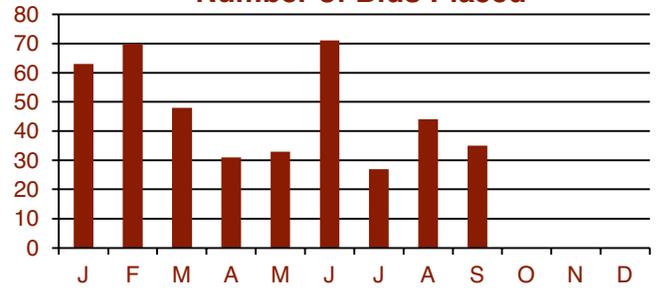
Number of Unique Bidders



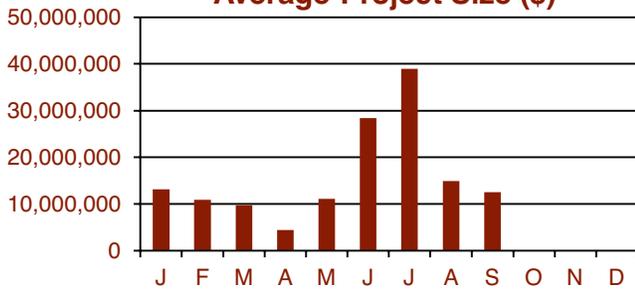
Number of Projects



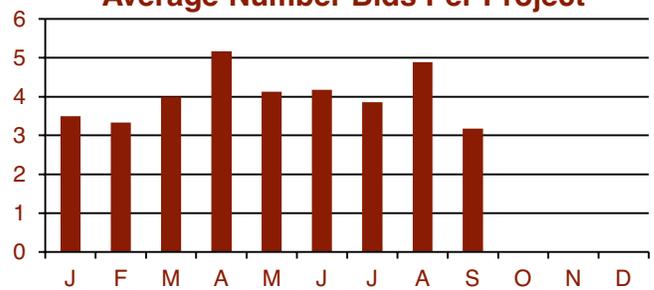
Number of Bids Placed
